McBride had already spent several days trying to lure the dolphins into his fine mesh nets. He worked during the day. He worked at night. He even worked in dark waters where the dolphin couldn't possibly see his nets. No matter where or when he worked and no matter how he arranged his nets, McBride couldn't catch a single dolphin. Finally, he switched to nets that had wider mesh. Only then did he succeed.

Later, he asked himself why one kind of net worked well, while another kind didn't work at all. Then (a) the answer came to him. The dolphins weren't relying on their sight to avoid his nets.

They were relying on echolocation. McBride reasoned that most sound waves would bounce back from the fine-meshed nets. These echoes would then warn the dolphins away. But the wide-meshed nets would have just the opposite effect.
