Park discovered a very old book, with the title clearly printed on the cover: *Jikji*. It was the second volume of *Baegun Hwasang Chorok Buljo Jikji Simche Yojeol*, written and published in the late Goryeo period. It was donated to the library in 1950, by a French art collector who ① had bought the book at an auction in 1911. To her surprise, an inscription at the end of the book ② read “printed with movable metal type at Heungdeok Temple in the seventh year of Seonkwang.” The year was 1377. If the inscription was true, it meant that the book was printed with movable metal type 78 years earlier than the Gutenberg Bible, which had long been thought to be the world’s first book printed with movable metal type.

It was a stunning discovery, but it did not seem that the world ③ would believe her. She needed _____. Park began to study ancient Korean printing technology and experimented with letter blocks ④ had made from various materials. After years of effort, she managed to find that the metal type printing leaves traces of metal on the edges of printed words. *Jikji* was proved ⑤ to have been printed with movable metal type.

Park discovered the royal books that had been taken away from *Oegyujanggak*. To find them, she searched every possible place for over 10 years, but her efforts were in vain. One day in 1977, her French co-worker told her that she had seen piles of damaged Chinese books in another building in the National Library. There she found 297 volumes of *Uigwe*, the royal books that recorded major national events in texts and images.

In 1978, Park told the Korean embassy and reporters in Paris about the books, and she insisted that the books should be returned to Korea. When the books became known to the world, she was forced to resign from her job for the reason that she had revealed some of the library’s secret information. However, she continued her research to interpret the records in *Uigwe*. The Korean government officially requested the return of the books in 1992.
